The Big Heifer: A celebration of your school

Skills:

- Develop performance skills needed for GCSE Drama
- Work collaboratively to generate, develop and communicate ideas
- Develop reflective practices, allowing for evaluation of one's own performance and the process as a whole
- Build design skills in prop, set and costume design
- Work with a professional technician to design and operate lights for the performance

Description:

A professional Director and Assistant Director will devise a new play with up to 20 of your students. We will use the students' imaginations to design and make their own costume and props, exploring how theatre can be made with what you have at home. Lights for the show will be provided by the assistant director whom a student will be able to support.

The Focussed Heifer: Building advanced skills

Skills:

- Develop advanced performance skills with a focus on physical characterisation and vocal range
- Explore and experiment with the use of space and the relationship with the audience
- Work collaboratively to generate, develop and communicate ideas
- Enhance reflective practices, allowing for evaluation of one's own performance and the process as a whole
- Build on design skills with practical and relevant application within the play (skills include lighting, sound, set, costume and prop design)
- Work with a professional technician to design, programme and operate lights
- Choice of working on set texts such as: Three Sisters (Inua Ellams), Cloud Nine (Caryl Churchill) or Brontë (Polly Teale) or devising

Age KS4/5 Length 48 hours Number of students 10 Performance length Circa 25 mins Cost £4.323

Description:

Boost your students' knowledge of practitioners through practice and research-based learning. Employing the theory and practice of each practitioner or company, we will create an original performance which develops students understanding of either the set texts or the devising process. This option is excellent for guiding students through the devising or rehearsal process at GCSE and A-Level, demonstrating how to realise the artistic vision across the entire mise-en-scène of the performance as well as performance style.

Pronoun by Evan Placey

Description: Pronoun is a touching and relevant play which explores the journey of two teens in love as one transitions from female to male. In this workshop series, we use the play to safely explore what it is to be transgender and the varied impacts it can have on the individual transitioning and the people around them.

Relationship Rehab

Description: Students will devise scenes with a director exploring what it is to be in a relationship and what choices you can make.

Once the scenes have been devised, we will use forum theatre techniques to encourage students to discuss what is happening and make suggestions as to how the issues could be handled differently.

Secrets

Description: A 20-minute performance where we are immersed into the world of Ayesha and Imogen. Celebrating their one-year anniversary, Ayesha discovers a secret that Imogen has been keeping from her that throws their relationship into disarray, jeopardising its future.

After watching the first performance, students will break into smaller groups to discuss the themes of the play and the behaviour of the characters. We will then re-group and give suggestions to the cast to change the performance. Ideas will be taken from each group and your students will be encouraged to take the reins completely directing and even acting in the performance!
